This month, I'll be talking about something we haven't seen for a while: The Lodge room. There are a few small details that I want to share since I haven't seen it mentioned lately in our Masonic education.

The Lodge room is usually situated due East and West not only because of King Solomon's temple was orientated so, since all Masonic lodges are based off of the King Solomon's mythos, but it was to model off of Moses' tabernacle, which was oriented due East and West to commemorate the mighty East wind that miraculously delivered the children of Israel through the Red Sea. King Solomon's temple was based off of Moses' original tabernacle in the wilderness of Sinai.

In the Lodge, there are 6 jewels, 3 movable and 3 immovable, which are concisely lectured by our Most Excellent Secretary. But another piece of symbolism that's recommended to be in a Lodge is a circumpoint within a circle that's bound by two parallel lines representing the patron Saints of Masonry, Saint John the Baptist and Saint John the

Evangelist. This piece of artwork I have written about last year and its symbolism could run deep, like many other rabbit holes in Masonry.

In the near future, I hope that Morning Star also will acquire a representation of this symbol that's near and dear to my heart.
